Programming Internship

Spanish proficiency required, 10 hours/week, unpaid

Responsibilities: Attending family outreach and programming events. Coordinate volunteers and scheduling with partner organizations. Communicate with families about scheduling. Develop templates for programming communications. Update website and social media. This position averages 6 hours of programming (Biking, Swimming, Etc.) and 4 hours of computer work and meetings.

Desired Qualifications: Spanish proficiency; experience or interest in learning mountain biking, swimming, climbing, environmental education, and backpacking; experience with google drive; basic website and social media development skills; experience working with and communicating in group settings; experience working with youth; engagement in social justice/DEI process.

Nonprofit Planning and Development Internship

Spanish helpful, not required, 10 hours/week, unpaid

Responsibilities: Plan and attend community events. Facilitate donations and fundraising with individuals, companies, and organization partners. Basic grant-writing. Work with Board of Directors Development and Governance Committees. Manage donor and fundraising databases. Evaluate and improve organization practices. This position is a mixture of meetings, working with the Executive Director, and working on a computer.

Desired Qualifications: Experience or interest in working in a non-profit setting; experience with google drive and excel; basic website and social media development skills, experience planning events; experience working in group settings; engagement in social justice/DEI process.

Social Media, Research, and Outreach Internship

Spanish helpful, not required, 10 hours/week, unpaid

Responsibilities: Create content for social media channels for Vamos Outdoors Project. Post content in a timely manner. Manage social media communication, in collaboration with other staff. Intern will design internal data gathering protocols and conduct interviews with staff and partners. Use film and photography to highlight Vamos Outdoors Project service. Position is a mixture of computer work, meetings, and attending programming/events.

Desired Qualifications: Familiarity with social media platforms; experience with photo and video creation; experience working in group settings; engagement in social justice process/DEI process.
